Trash Bash: A Recycling Art Competition

Celebrate Earth Day...Everyday! Last year's Trash Bash was so successful, the Family Earth Day Celebration committee has decided to host the art competition again! Local school-age children can enter art projects, as long as 75% of the project includes reused materials (items that were going to go the landfill or to be recycled).

There are four different age groups, divided by grade: K-2nd, 3rd-5th, 6th-8th, and 9th-12th. The projects will be judged by local artists and/or art enthusiasts. There will be prizes/awards given at 1:00 pm!

This can be a project for an art class, an art club, an extra credit opportunity, or even completed as an individual at home! Below are the guidelines for the art show.

Guidelines:

1. In order to participate, 75% of the art should include items that are being reused (things that would normally be going into either the landfill or to be sent off to be recycled).
2. The finished project should be dropped off at Cope Environmental Center (4910 Shoemaker Rd, Centerville, IN 47330) NO LATER than Friday, April 21 at 4:00 pm.
3. When dropping off artwork, parent or student must submit or fill out a note card (we will provide notecards on site) with Artist's name, name of the piece, description of the piece and materials used (mainly the recycled materials), grade, and school.
4. There is a weight limit of 20 pounds on all art. If submissions are 3-D, it must be able to sit/stand on its own.
5. Only one entry per student will be accepted (you can turn in a project as a group/class, but then the student cannot do an individual project).
6. Art piece should be student's own work, as well as an original and should not violate any U.S. copyright laws.
7. Artwork that is submitted and displayed for this show must remain in the show for its entirety. Awards will be given at 1:00 pm and students' artwork must be picked up between 1:30 - 2 pm on April 23, 2016. We DO NOT have any way of storing the artwork. Please take artwork home after the Family Earth Day Celebration.
