

Children at the Primary level learn to love God through Bible stories shared during Children's Mass every Wednesday. Stories of Catholic Saints like St. Francis of Assisi, St. Nicholas and St. Patrick are woven into the classroom, alongside the "Golden Rule" and learning how to treat others with kindness and respect.

Intermediate students are given the opportunity to grow their faith in so many ways! Students attend a weekly Communion Service on Mondays, as well as, Mass and Eucharistic Adoration every Thursday.

Catholic and non-Catholic students alike share experiences that strengthen their love for Jesus! Besides Religion class, and weaving our Christian faith into everyday classroom work, the following faith strengthening activities take place:

- Students participate in weekly Mass with active roles as greeters, instrumentalists, song leaders, gift bearers, readers and altar children.
- Rosary is prayed once a month as a school.
- Special prayer services are held each week during Advent.
- The Stations of the Cross are prayed during Lent.
- All students from 3 year old preschool to 12th grade come together three times per year for an All School Mass.
- Various convocations yearly on the missions, Mary, the Catholic Mass and the conversions.
- Grades 3-6 celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year.
- 5th grade holds on an overnight retreat at St. Meinrad Archabbey in Ferdinand, Indiana.
- 6th grade has an overnight retreat at Camp Rancho Framasa in Columbus, Indiana.
