The following scholarships are available for the 2017-2018 school year to students in grades 9-12. Some have eligibility requirements. Please check those carefully. Select the scholarships below that you would like to apply for. All scholarship applications must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation along with the form at the end of this application. All applicants will also write an essay (500-1000 words) on the following topic to submit along with this scholarship application:

_____ **The Angela Brinker Scholarship** – up to \$500, for a student that shows financial need - must fill out FACTS Grant & Aid application to qualify.

_____ **The Archbishop Daniel Buechlein, OSB Scholarship** - up to \$1000 - This scholarship will be awarded to a student who exemplifies the traits of character outlined in Seton Catholic High School's code of conduct.

_____ **The Ramona J. Benson Scholarship** - up to \$500, available to incoming freshman

_____ **The First Bank Richmond Scholarship** - up to \$1000, for a student that shows financial need - must fill out FACTS Grant & Aid application to qualify.

_____ **The Eileen Hunt Scholarship** - up to \$1000, for a student that shows financial need - must fill out FACTS Grant & Aid application to qualify.

_____ **The Father Todd Riebe Scholarship** - up to \$1000

_____ **The Gloria J. and Richard McClaren Scholarship** - up to \$1000

_____ **The St. Thomas Aquinas Scholarship** - up to \$1000

_____ **The Thomas and Mary Fisher Scholarship** - up to \$500, available to an incoming freshman who maintain at least a “B” average.

_____ **The Mother Theresa Scholarship** - up to \$1000 – This scholarship will be awarded to a student who exemplifies the spirit of service in their school and parish community.

_____ **CWU Scholarship** - \$300 – This scholarship is available to a girl that will be in 11th grade, and is a member of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church. This young woman must be a practicing Catholic, with average or above average grades, and should represent good moral values and Christian ideals.

**All scholarship applications, essays and letters of recommendation must be submitted to the Seton Catholic High School office by April 27, 2017 to be considered. No incomplete applications will be reviewed.*
