

Welcome to Seton Intermediate!

We are so excited to have you join us for 3rd grade at the Intermediate Building! The transition from Primary to Intermediate can be a little worrisome, but we promise things will be good! We wanted to outline some of the things that you can anticipate....

- The first bell rings at 7:50 am, and the tardy bell rings at 8 am.
- Dismissal time is 2:50 pm.
- All students must wear a belt daily.

- Students attend Communion Service on Monday mornings, and Mass on Thursday. They will have public speaking experience by reading for Mass and Rosary.
- There is a daily student planner to keep track of assignments. This teaches student responsibility and facilitates parent-teacher communications.
- Students will have nightly homework and weekly tests.
- All subjects receive letter grades. Social Studies and Science will be graded subjects during the second semester.
- Responsibility shifts from parents to students.
- We utilize the Accelerated Reading Program, and it is a part of the Reading grade.

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
